Mrs Helen Dwyer is off on another adventure next term as she steps into the Acting Principal position at Stratford Primary School until the start of December. We wish her well in this role.

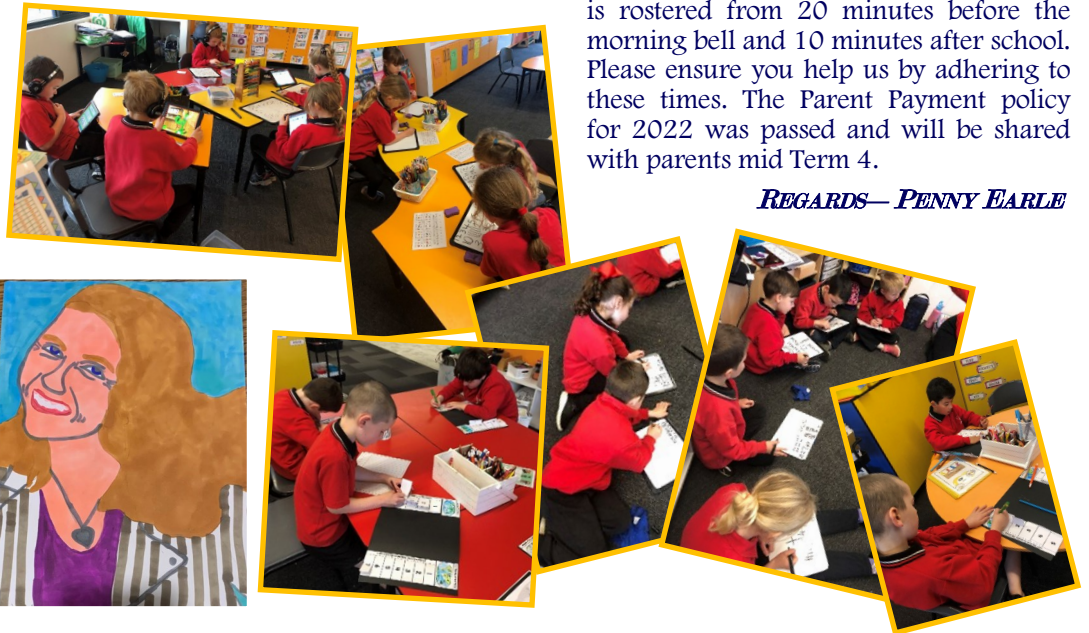
SCHOOL COUNCIL
