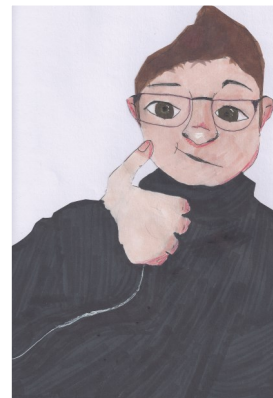
Macy
